Greetings in the Wonderful Name of Jesus Christ

In our last newsletter, we told you that four great hurricanes: Fay, Gustav, Hanna and Ike have almost destroyed the Nation of Haiti. Gustav has done a lot of devastations to Haiti. The country is now undergoing their terrible consequences.

Haiti is a country which undergoes the consequences of deforestation of the land by the people who, due to lack of work, cut the trees in order to make charcoal to sell to buy food for their family. Now when a big rain comes it causes floods that drain the good soils into the sea, the same kill the fish there. Thus, the poverty of the people is getting alarming every day.

For over two weeks, heavy rains have fallen in many parts of the country. The metropolitan area of Port-au-Prince has been suffering under heavy floods that brought a lot of debris into the city that render life very hard here. Some sewers were left wide open. Many people fell therein so that one of them died. Others were plugged up and the waters run into the streets. The flooding was so devastating that it killed two people in one night in the slums area of the city.

Starvation

The cost of food is very high. As most of the people are not working, they are unable to buy food whose price is very high and is rising every day. Parents are under a lot of stress when they can not have money to buy groceries to feed their children. We thank all our friends who are supporting the feeding program in the schools. It is a very good investment in the kingdom of the Lord Jesus Christ. We pray that others will join us in this program to feed more children in order to keep them from starvation.

Schools Tuition Program

About two years ago, under the suggestion of our friend, Brad Potter who knew our struggle with school children who could not pay their tuition, we started a school tuition program when we asked good Christians to help us with supporting a child by paying 25 dollars a month for his/her tuition, uniform and books. Many people cared and responded to this call. Now we have 127 children's being able to attend school because of the goodness of those good Christians and friends. Thank God for them! We particularly thank each one of you who are taking a part in providing education to the poor children here in Haiti.

The Deliverance of Lovelie Alieriste

Lovelie Alieriste is a young girl who lives at Williamson, a village about 1h30mn from Port-au-Prince. She was possessed on September 10, 2009 by an evil spirit. Thinking she had a mental problem, her parents took her to a psychiatric center for help. The diagnostic was negative. No psychiatric or medical cure could help. She was taken to a witch doctor who asked 20,000 haitian dollars for her treatment. Though they were poor, they collected a fund raising for 3, 000 haitian dollars from relatives and friends. They gave that money to the witch doctor, hoping that he would exorcise the evil spirit. But the case of Lovelie got worse day by day. During some treatment sessions, the former kept her naked and she was humiliated. There was no improvement.

When she got her mind at times, she told her parents to take her to Pastor Jassonn Remy, a pastor of the Independent Christian Alliance Church there. The people of that church went and prayed for her day and night. And that girl was delivered from the power of the devil and regained her sound mind because of the power of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I visited that church on Sunday, September 27; Lovelie talked to me, praising the Lord Jesus Christ for her deliverance, she was very happy. Glory to God!

THE BIGGEST IMMEDIATE NEED: A Church being built and lack of fund

The Church in Carrefour was opened since January 1976. It became the headquarter where the Annual Conference for all the 53 churches of the Independent Christian Church is held for instruction and teaching in order to prepare and improve the Christian workers' performance in their ministries to fulfill the demands of the Great Commission. However, for many years, it became too small to hold all the participants who came from the country churches and the surrounding ones, so that during the service on Sunday morning of the Conference, some people had to stay under the sun outside the building, without being able to hear the teaching that was giving inside.

This situation led us to start a building to accommodate the people and attract sinners who, according to the Haitian culture will be more interested to get saved in that Church when we evangelize them.
